Born on 11 December 1974 in Gdańsk.

Graduated from University of Gdańsk, Faculty of International Relations, and Gdynia Maritime Academy (now Gdynia Maritime University), Faculty of Management.

Started his political activity from the Liberal Democratic Congress (KLD) and its Youth Community - Association "Young Liberals"; after KLD united with the Democratic Union (UD), became member of the the Freedom Union (UW) and the Association "Young Democrats"; is member of the Civic Platform from the very beginning (2001).

Between 1998 and 2000, adviser in the Political Cabinet of Minister of National Defence Janusz Onyszkiewicz.

Between 1998 and 2002, chairman of the Association "Young Democrats" - the biggest political youth organisation in Poland; during his term of office, the association joined the Civic Platform.

Member of Parliament in the 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th tenure; member of the Commission for National Defence and the Commission for Foreign Affairs in the Parliament; achieved the best results in his constituency for the parliamentary elections of 2007 and 2011.

Between 2007 and 2009, secretary of state at the Chancellery of the Prime Minister and Director of the Political Cabinet in the government of Donald Tusk.

Between 2009 and 2010, deputy chairman of the Parliamentary Club "Civic Platform".

In May 2010, became head of the Civic Platform in the Pomeranian Region.

Between 2010 and 2011, secretary of state at the Chancellery of President of the Republic of Poland Bronisław Komorowski, responsible for cooperation with the government and the parliament.

Led winning election campaigns for the Civic Platform twice - parliamentary elections in 2007, and presidential election in 2011.

Married, two children.
